

JWGA Closing Day

General Meeting – Sawgrass CC

May 11, 2026

President Deborah Eady called the meeting to order at 2:00 and welcomed everyone to the Closing Day lunch meeting of the JWGA 2025-26 season. She thanked everyone for playing during the season and also for playing in this event. She then turned the floor over to Vice President, Shauna Snyder.

VP Snyder thanked Shari Zeimetz and Therese Quinn for their assistance in securing Timuquana Country Club as venue for 100th Anniversary event to be held on November 3, 2027. Timuquana was the site of the very first JWGA golf outing and it is fitting that we return there to celebrate this significant milestone.

Secretary: Reading of the minutes from the March 4 Anniversary tournament were waived; minutes were accepted.

Treasurer: Cindy Riley advised that copies of the Treasurer's Report were on the tables. She also said that 20 dues payments were turned in today and that the organization was in good financial shape.

Golf Chair Adrienne Whitman thanked the Club Reps for their help in securing venues and coordinating events.

Playday Chair Michelle Dufresne also thanked the Club Reps and Shari Zeimetz.

Tournament Management Shari Zeimetz announced the change in cancellation policy from 48 to 72 hours. This was implemented because of the deadline for providing rosters to the clubs, especially if lunch is involved. Shari also thanked Jody Clark and Lori Collins for their help. She also advised that the 2026-27 schedule would be on the website August 1st.

Majors Chair Linda Hoffman – no report.

Prize Chair Shannon Stanley – no report. President Eady said that prizes would be awarded later.

Membership: Pam Murdock not in attendance but per her written report, the following new members were introduced: Amy Alcini/Fernandina Beach, Maryjane Stevens/Golf Club of Amelia Island and Nancy Hanna/San Jose Country Club.

Rules Chair Tama Caldabaugh thanked the Club Reps for getting the Rules Quizzes on the carts each week and noted that the Pace of Play tips will be added to the website. The list of members who turned in at

least 10 rules quizzes was available on the tables; they each receive 1 point. The top three were recognized:

1st Place – 4 points - Shari Zeimetz – 18 crowned Rules Queen.

2nd Place – 3 points - Debra McDermott – 17

3rd Place – Suzanne LaPlante – 16

Historian - Shan Giordano – No Report. Asked Flight Winners to assemble for a picture.

Computer and Media Information, Jeri Roche thanked Shari Zeimetz and Adrienne Whitman.

Charity Announcement Thank you to Terri Wensell for spearheading the fundraising effort for Clay County she presented \$2350 to Executive Director Saige Holder for the Safe Animal Shelter from JWGA.

Awards Presentation. Tama Caldabaugh was presented with the JWGA Championship trophy. She has won the Championship 9 times. Chris Hunt was the winner of the Senior Division and Deb Caruso was the Super Senior Division winner. The Most Improved Golfer of the Year was Jennifer DiPaula.

Survey Results:

- Responses: 141 responses out of a possible 189 or a 75% response rate

Stunning response demonstrating our membership's engagement with our association. Well done.

Makes the responses statistically significant and provides the Board with a blue print of Members' desires.

- Question 1 - 60% want to see a return to the previous Championship format.
- Question 2 - 70% want to return to alternating the Championship between gross stroke and gross match play.
- Question 3 - 69.5% want to see the Senior/Super Senior Championship added back to the golf schedule.
- Question 4 - 64.5% want the Handicap match play to be flighted and a shoot out to determine the winner.
- Question 5 - 68% want to see the Match Play consolation rounds started after the first week.

- Question 6 - 67% (95 respondents) felt it would make no difference if a qualifier was on a Monday with a first round on the following Wednesday.
- Question 7 - 85% felt occasionally playing a JWGA event on a Monday rather than a Wednesday would be okay.
- Question 8 - 45% wanted pairings arranged more heavily with 41% wanting to see it more evenly weighted and only 13.5% (19 people) wanted to make their own pairings.
- Question 9 - 62% (87) said do not bring back the Grandmother's Tournament.
- Question 10- 55% (77) said expand the membership to include Palm Coast/FlaglerCounty.
- Question 11 - 67% (95) said eliminate printing the JWGA Book.

Further Discussion:

Pairings: There was a question regarding how pairings are done in Golf Genius. Pairings can be random, ABCD and AB.

President's Cup: The format of the President's Cup came up for discussion. A suggestion was made to consider going back to the old format with the last 6 holes played as individual match play.

Survey: President Eady advised that the Survey and any other issues would be discussed at the upcoming Board Meeting on May 13.

Election of Officers: Past President and Nominating Committee Chair Vickie Galpin conducted the election of Officers for the 2026-27 Season. The Slate of Officers is as follows:

- Vice President - Shauna Snyder
- Secretary - Carol Williams
- Treasurer - Cindy Riley

There were no nominations from the floor. Above Slate of Officers was reelected.

The meeting was adjourned at 2:25.
